**FINAL DECREE**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of Fansteel Inc. ("Reorganized Fansteel"), as successor by merger to Custom Technologies Corp., the debtor herein ("Custom"), for entry of a final decree closing the Custom chapter 11 case pursuant to section 350(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. § 350(a), and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3022, and Reorganized Fansteel having given due notice of the Motion to the U. S. Trustee for the District of Delaware and all parties requesting notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002, and no other notice being required; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

**THE COURT FINDS that:**

- a. The Confirmation Order has become final;
- b. The property required to be transferred by the Plan has been transferred and the successor to Custom has assumed the business or the management of the property dealt with by the Plan;
- c. Plan payments have commenced and the Plan has been substantially consummated;
- d. All motions, contested matters and adversary proceedings relating to Custom and its estate have been resolved; and

e. The estate of Custom has been fully administered.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:**

1. The Motion is granted; and
2. The Chapter 11 case of Custom Technologies Corp., Case No. 02-10111,

is closed.
