SUBJECT: POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2 - RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 2004-01, "REQUIREMENTS FOR STEAM GENERATOR TUBE INSPECTIONS" (TAC NOS. MC4840 AND MC4841)

On August 30, 2004, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Generic Letter (GL) 2004-01, "Requirements For Steam Generator Tube Inspections." The purpose of GL 2004-01 was to obtain information that would enable the NRC staff to determine whether licensee's steam generator (SG) tube inspection programs comply with the existing tube inspection requirements (the plant technical specifications in conjunction with Appendix B to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 50 Appendix B).

By letter dated October 29, 2004, Nuclear Management Company, LLC, responded to GL 2004-01 for Point Beach Nuclear Plant (PBNP), Units 1 and 2. The NRC staff's review of your response to the GL 2004-01 did not identify any concerns with the inspection practices employed at PBNP, Units 1 and 2. The NRC staff, therefore, concludes that your SG tube inspection practices are in compliance with the existing tube inspection requirements.
