2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 74 x 48Y "Heeled" Cylinders loaded on two lash barges. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, non fissile or fissile-excepted. Heeled cylinders, total net weight of U is 195.5 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 1.4 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The surface transportation from Paducah, KY will be the responsibility of TAM International Inc. The US inland waterway transportation from Paducah, KY to New Orleans, LA will be the responsibility of American Commercial Barge Line. The ocean transportation from New Orleans, LA to Immingham, United Kingdom will be the responsibility of Forest Line Inc. 
