Dear Mr. Murphy:

This refers to the subject reports and our letter dated June 30, 2005, that transmitted these reports to you. Our letter described the inspection and investigation findings and explained the three options available to you to respond to the inspection findings before the NRC makes a final enforcement decision. Your letter dated July 7, 2005, stated that you prefer to attend a Predecisional Enforcement Conference (conference) and provided us with your preference for the dates and times for the conference.

Pursuant to the request in your letter, and as Sattar Lodhi of my staff discussed with you on July 15, we have scheduled the conference for July 28, 2005, at 1:00 p.m. in the Public Meeting Room of NRC Region I office in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. Directions to the Region I Office are enclosed. While a public announcement will be made about the conference, the conference is closed to the public. The conference will be transcribed. During the conference you should be prepared to provide your perspective on the inspection and investigation findings, your corrective actions and any other information that you wish the NRC to take into consideration before making an enforcement decision.

Region I has received notifications from you on June 24, 2005 and July 13, 2005 of damage to two different nuclear gauges at two temporary job sites in Virginia. Our review of these events is continuing and will be subject of a future inspection. However, we would appreciate it if you would be prepared to discuss these events following the conference, including any corrective actions you have taken or plan to prevent recurrence.
