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Dear Ms. Ullrich,

I have included responses to each of the items requested in your June 22, 2005 letter that are applicable to change the licensee to Bayhealth Medical Center.

- a. Provide a complete description of the transaction (transfer of stocks or assets, or merger)

Central Delaware Oncology Center, Inc. (CDOC) was originally formed with two shareholders: L.W. Brady, MD and Bayhealth Development Corporation (BHDC), sister corporation to Bayhealth Medical Center, Inc. (BHMC). Both BHDC and BHMC are under control of Bayhealth, Inc., the parent corporation. L.W. Brady, MD sold his interest in CDOC to BHDC due to scaling back his medical practice. BHDC then sold the land, building and equipment of CDOC to BHMC, in effect becoming a department of BHMC. BHMC has always been involved with the program, only the name of the contact has changed.

- b. Indicate whether the name has changed and include the new name. Include the name and telephone number of a licensee contact who 'NRC may contact if more information is needed.

Name has changed to Bayhealth Medical Center.

- e. Describe the status of the surveillance program (surveys, wipe tests, quality control) at the present time and the expected status at the time that control is to be transferred.

- f. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

All records concerning surveys, past problems of the facility associated with spills or previous use of radioactive material on the license, positive leakage identified or lack of leakage associated with licensed materials, and all records associated with the radiation safety program related to license will be transferred to transferee.

- g. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

Yes, Bayhealth Medical Center will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, and commitments.

In addition, we request that Dr. Luther W. Brady be removed as an authorized user for this license. We also request that John Lahaniatis, MD be added as an authorized user to the license (License Number SUB-1513). Dr. Lahaniatis is currently an authorized user for two other NRC licenses (07-14850-01 and 07-14900-01) for use of by-product material permitted under 10 CFR 35.300 and 10 CFR 35.400.


