He reported that the Claymont, DE, facility is in the process of being closed and all radioactive material has been removed from the licensee facility and transferred to the fixed gauge manufacturer who is licensed to accept the material. He now wants to know what actions are required to terminate that license. He reported that the RSO for this license is no longer employed by General Chemical.</p> <p>I directed Mr. Huth to NUREG-1556, Vol. 4 (fixed gauges) and provided him with verbal guidance relative to what supporting documentation we will need submitted along with his NRC Form 314. Mr. Huth reported that the completed NRC Form 314 requesting termination of the license will be submitted as soon as practical (within the next week or so).</p> <p>As part of the phone conversation, Jim Schmidt reviewed the May 2002 inspection results for this facility in ADAMS and confirmed that the licensee had 9 sealed sources at that time. As part of the phone conversation, Mr. Huth verified that he has disposal records from all nine sources.</p> </div> </div>
