NRC SCHEDULES PUBLIC WORKSHOP AUGUST 4 ON INSPECTION PROCEDURES AT NRC-REGULATED FUEL FACILITIES

U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in the Region II office in Atlanta have scheduled a day-long workshop on Thursday, August 4, to discuss proposed revised fuel facility inspection procedures.

The workshop is slated to begin at 7:30 a.m. and last until 5:00 p.m. in the NRC's Region II office, located on the 24th floor at 61 Forsyth Street in Atlanta. The meeting is open to NRC licensees, applicants, industry representatives, members of the public and media. NRC fuel facility inspection procedures are being revised to incorporate the requirements of Subpart H to Part 70 of the NRC's regulations, including licensees' Integrated Safety Analyses.
