To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this correspondence as our reply to your letter dated June 7, 2005 (Postmarked June 28, 2005) regarding an inspection performed on May 18, 2005. The violation cited was that our shipping paper referred to identification number UN2974 instead of UN3332.

The reason for the violation was an oversight on our part. The UN 2974 number was as received by us from the supplier of the gauge. The corrective step was to correct the identification number to UN3332. The corrective step taken to ensure that this type of oversight does not reoccur was to employ an outside agency to conduct a review of our entire radiation safety program. A Radiation Safety Program Audit was conducted on May 25, 2005. On that date, the Radiation Training/Inspection Manager from NETS reviewed our program, provided us with checklists and organized our files. They will also mail us reminders of certain ongoing requirements to be fulfilled (such as leak testing dates). Full compliance was achieved on that date (May 25, 2005).
