This is in reference to the request in your letter dated May 20, 1992, for additional information to continue the review of our application for approval pursuant to 10 CFR 20.302 for the burial of animal carcasses contaminated with licensed material at the Agricultural Research Service's Jornada Experimental Range, Dona Ana County, New Mexico.

Item a. of your letter requested a description of the relation of the burial site location to the surrounding environs and a map showing the site and property boundaries. The enclosed maps describe the surrounding environs and show all relevant boundaries.

Item b. of your letter requested that a notation indicating the location of the burial site be made on local government land records. The enclosed letter dated June 30, 1992, from Kris Havstad, Director of the Jornada Experimental Range, describes the action we have taken to notify local government land officials of the burial site location.

Item c. of your letter requested a certification from the officials executing this application that the information contained in the application is accurate. The enclosed letter from K. Havstad dated June 18, 1992, makes the appropriate certification.
