<p>Summary:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">In the amendment received 5/2/05, the licensee requested that they be permitted to name an Alternate RSO, because the current RSO could be deployed for greater than 60 days each year. 10 CFR 35.24(c) allows the licensee to have an Alternate RSO for up to 60 days each year. The request was not granted.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Based on the Closed Items Table for the Part 35 Implementation Working Group this request was introduced by Ireland Army Community Hospital (Closed Item #101). Ireland Army Community Hospital did not pursue the request, however the Group decided that the Region should obtain the following information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The licensee must address 10 CFR 35.19.</li> <li>2. The licensee must explain why they wish to appoint a person RSO when the individual is expected to be absent frequently.</li> <li>3. Explain the extenuating circumstances that make it necessary to have a temporary RSO.</li> <li>4. They should provide a set number of days each year that a temporary RSO would be used.</li> </ol> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">On 7/26/05 I discussed with MAJ Cooper the information we would need to consider an exemption to 10 CFR 35.23(c). MAJ Cooper stated that he was not sure that he would want to pursue this issue at this time.</p>		
<p>Action Required: Wait for information, then consider the exemption to 10 CFR 35.20(c)</p>
