As you are aware, on the basis of discussions with Duke Cogema Stone & Webster (DCS) Department of Energy (DOE)/National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) had planned to receive an application for a license to operate the Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility at the Savannah River Site in April, 2005.

The NRC is requesting that, in its response to this letter, DCS provide the current estimated date for the submittal of the license application. If this date is currently unknown, we request that DCS inform the NRC of the date not less than one year prior to the submittal. In addition, for planning and budgeting purposes, we request that you inform us of the approximate schedule for, and the extent of, interactions with the NRC staff that you are anticipating before the application is submitted.
