Ladies and Gentlemen:

In its February 11, 2005, letter Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) notified the NRC that SNC was working toward the submittal of an application for an Early Site Permit (ESP) in the Summer of 2006. Since that notification, site-specific data collection, preliminary application development activities and other ESP activities have begun, with SNC in the near future starting to conduct seismic borings and other ESP-related activities at the Alvin W. Vogtle Electric Generating Plant site near Waynesboro, Georgia as part of the evaluation of that site. Consistent with your Inspection Manual Chapter 2501-05, a meeting may be appropriate at this time to discuss the NRC's observation of data collection methodology, review our schedule for application development and generally discuss the NRC's desired coordination and involvement.

SNC requests that, subject to your availability, this meeting be held during the week of August 15, 2005. An agenda for your review and comment is included as Enclosure 1.

To support scheduling of potential pre-docketing inspections over the next few weeks, SNC has included a portion of its schedule as Enclosure 2. SNC will advise the NRC of pertinent changes to this schedule.
