Please allow this correspondence to serve as a response to your correspondence dated July 6, 2005, in which you requested further information about an application for amendment to NRC License No. 37-18104-01, Forbes Regional Hospital sent to you June 14, 2005.

a. Prior to July 1, 2005, The Western Pennsylvania Hospital (WPH) and Forbes Regional Hospital (FRH) were separate federally tax exempt Pennsylvania nonprofit corporations. The sole corporate member of both WPH and FRH was the West Penn Allegheny Health System, Inc. (WPAHS), also a federally tax exempt Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation.

FRH operated an acute care community hospital located at 2570 Haymaker Road, Monroeville, PA 15146 (the Forbes Regional Campus). WPH operates, among other health care services, a tertiary hospital located at 4800 Friendship Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15224 (the West Penn Campus).

Effective July 1, 2005, FRH merged with and into WPH, with WPH as the surviving corporation and FRH ceasing to exist as a separate corporation, as part of an internal corporate reorganization. WPAHS remains the sole member of WPH. WPH is currently operating two separately licensed, acute care hospital campuses, one located at the West Penn Campus and one located at the Forbes Regional Campus. Each campus will continue to follow the radiation safety policies and procedures that were in place prior to the merger, including separate radiation safety officers and radiation safety committees.

b. The name of Forbes Regional Hospital has been changed to The Western Pennsylvania Hospital-Forbes Regional Campus. The individual whom the NRC may contact for information is:
