This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on July 12, 2005, at a temporary job site on interstate highway 90 west of Pierre. This inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, and interviews with personnel. The inspection findings were discussed with Lance DeMers of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. A final telephonic exit was conducted with you on July 19, 2005.
