SUBJECT: Answer and Response to Order for Additional Security Measures on the Transportation of Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.4, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) hereby submits information in response to the Order for Additional Security Measures on the Transportation of Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern (RAMQC) (hereinafter "Order") issued by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on July 18, 2005.

OPPD consents to the Order and specifically does not request a hearing. OPPD does not currently have any RAMQC shipments scheduled and does not anticipate any RAMQC shipments for the foreseeable future.

This letter contains the following regulatory commitments:

- OPPD will notify the NRC ninety (90) days in advance of the first RAMQC shipment if conditions change requiring OPPD to ship RAMQC. (AR 37598)
- OPPD will implement the requirements of the Order prior to the first RAMQC shipment if conditions change requiring OPPD to ship RAMQC. (AR37598)
