SAVANNAH facility has not shipped radioactive waste since approximately 1975, and has no near-term plans to ship radioactive materials; thus, implementation compliance with the terms of this order shall be as prescribed in paragraph III.A; i.e., "before the next shipment after the 180 day implementation period of this order."
