This letter is to request an amendment to Immunomedics, Inc. USNRC Materials License No. 29-30097-01. This amendment will allow us to remove the requirement that radioactive materials be decayed-in-storage for a minimum of ten half-lives prior to disposal without regard to radioactivity. We intend to comply with the requirements of 10 CFR 20.2001 and of 10 CFR 35.92 (Decay-in-storage):

Therefore we ask to change paragraph 1 of Item 11 of our original license renewal application dated May 7, 2004 to the following:

1. Radionuclides with half lives shorter than 120 days, are allowed to decay in storage are disposed as normal trash when a survey with an appropriate radiation detector (GM based detector) shows no reading different from the reading from the natural background sources. This material is stored in the waste storage areas. Records of each container, indicating the start date, the final survey data and the disposal date will be kept for the life of the license. All radiation labels are removed before disposal.
