34. A. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use the radioactive material authorized by this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in the following:

application dated August 29, 1995,
 letters dated August 1, 1997, September 10, 1997, February 3, 1999, March 30, 2000,
 September 8, 2000, October 25, 2000, January 25, 2001, October 23, 2002,
 October 24, 2002, January 9, 2003, July 30, 2003, August 28, 2003, February 5, 2004,
 and June 28, 2004.

Title 25 TAC §289 shall prevail over statements contained in the above documents unless such statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

- B. The licensee shall comply with the requirements described in the DSHS letter dated () and attached document entitled "Increased Controls for Licensees that Possess Sources Containing Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern." The licensee shall complete implementation of said requirements within 6 months from the issuance of the license amendment or the first day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in Table 1 of the attachment, whichever is later. Within 30 days after the implementation of the requirements of this condition, the licensee shall notify the Radiation Safety Licensing Branch in writing that it has completed the requirements of this condition.
