This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on July 28, 2005, at a temporary job site located in Idaho Falls, Idaho. The inspection results were discussed with you during a final telephonic exit briefing conducted on August 4, 2005.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent radiation measurements, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
