MR. PARTICIPANT: Hello, Bill. Wayne
Lanning here.

based on cool down we are planning on terminating at

8 want to terminate and then have to go out with an
9 unusual event and reactivate or reinitiate another
10 activation.

11 MR. PARTICIPANT: All right. Got it. All
12 right. Any other questions? All right, Bill. We
13 still haven't heard from the Chemistry folks regarding
14 steam generator delta.

15 MR. HOFFNER: We are still working. We
16 still do not have blown down on. However, we are not
17 steaming that generator either.
