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MR. GOTT: This is NRC Ops Center Support  
Line.

MR. SMITH: Yes, is Mr. Costa there  
please?

MR. GOTT: No, Mr. Costa has left for the  
day.

MR. SMITH: Okay. He called me this  
morning approximately at 10:45 a.m. concerning a  
report there at Millstone 3.

MR. GOTT: And you are?

MR. SMITH: Mike Smith, DOE Operations  
Center.

MR. GOTT: Okay. DOE.

MR. SMITH: Right, and he said he was

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1 going to send a hard copy and we have not received it  
2 as yet.

3 MR. GOTT: Okay, and how did he say he was  
4 going to send it you?

5 MR. SMITH: He said he was working on it  
6 and it should be out shortly. If he sends it email,  
7 it would fine.

8 MR. GOTT: A hard copy of our report?

9 MR. SMITH: Yes.

10 MR. GOTT: Okay. What's your email?

11 MR. SMITH: Hold on one second, sir. Let  
12 me make sure I get it. You can send -- I'll tell you  
13 what you can do. You can send it to DOEHQ.

14 MR. GOTT: Okay.

15 MR. SMITH: EOC@.

16 MR. GOTT: Okay.

17 MR. SMITH: Hold on one second.

18 MR. GOTT: Okay.

19 MR. SMITH: Okay. Sorry for the delay,  
20 sir. DOEHQEOC.

21 MR. GOTT: And that's all strung together.

22 MR. SMITH: Right, that's all strung  
23 together. @oem.doe.gov.

24 MR. GOTT: @oem.doe.gov. Okay. We didn't  
25 get the whole thing put together until about an hour

1 ago because there are things that are still coming in.

2 MR. SMITH: Okay.

3 MR. GOTT: Sir, I will email it to you  
4 right now.

5 MR. SMITH: I appreciate it, sir.

6 MR. GOTT: And then it won't go any  
7 further than your ops center.

8 MR. SMITH: That's affirmative.

9 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you.

10 MR. SMITH: Thank you. Bye.

11 MR. GOTT: Bye.

12 (Pause.)

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MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center Support Line.

MR. HOFFNER: This is Bill Hoffner,

Director of Station Emergency Response at Millstone.

Can you page or tie me through to Wayne Lanning.

MR. GOTT: Your name again, sir.

24

MR. HOFFNER: Bill Hoffner.

25

MR. GOTT: Okay.

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1 MR. HOFFNER: Thank you.

2 MR. GOTT: I'll mic off for a second while  
3 I transfer you. Okay?

4 MR. HOFFNER: Understand, I'll just hang  
5 on.

6 MR. GOTT: This is Headquarters Operations  
7 Officer. I have Bill Hoffner from Millstone who would  
8 like to be bridged. Can I put him on?

9 MR. HOFFNER: Bill, what kind of cooldown?  
10 Are we still maintaining 60 -- what sustained?

11 MR. GOTT: Sir, I'm going to transfer you  
12 to the bridge now.

13 MR. HOFFNER: Understand. Transfer.

14 (Phone call ended.)

15 (Off line.)

16 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center this is a  
17 recorded line.

18 MR. TRAPP: Yes, this is Jim Trapp and I  
19 was wondering if you would be kind enough to patch me  
20 to the ENS bridge for the Millstone event.

21 MR. GOTT: I will put you up on the ENS  
22 bridge.

23 MR. TRAPP: We ran out of batteries.  
24 Thank you.

25 MR. GOTT: Okay.

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1 (Phone call ended.)

2 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center this is a  
3 recorded line.

4 MR. HOFFNER: Ops Support Line, this is  
5 Bill Hoffner. Director of Emergency Operations at  
6 Millstone Station. Can you connect me to Wayne?

7 MR. GOTT: Let me connect you. When  
8 they're ready for you, I'll put you up. Mike, hold on  
9 a second.

10 MR. PARTICIPANT: Can you call them and  
11 see the status?

12 MR. PARTICIPANT: Yes.

13 MR. GOTT: Sir, I'm transferring you up on  
14 the bridge right now.

15 MR. PARTICIPANT: I understand you're  
16 transferring me right now.

17 (Phone call ended.)

18 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center Support Line.

19 MR. DODSON: Yes, this is Dave Dodson at  
20 the Millstone Power Station.

21 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

22 MR. DODSON: I'm the Station licensing  
23 supervisor and I would like to provide an update to  
24 our event notification 41607.

25 MR. GOTT: Okay, Mr. Dodson. I'm ready.

1 MR. DODSON: This is an update information  
2 previously transmitted at 1330 today, April 17, 2005.

3 MR. GOTT: Okay.

4 MR. DODSON: The previously reported time  
5 of the alert declaration should be corrected to read  
6 0842.

7 MR. GOTT: 0842.

8 MR. DODSON: Millstone Unit 3 entered Mode  
9 4 at approximately 1903 hours on April 17, 2005.

10 MR. GOTT: Okay.

11 MR. DODSON: The event at Millstone Unit  
12 3 was terminated at 1905 hours.

13 MR. GOTT: 1905. Okay.

14 MR. DODSON: The cause of the event is  
15 under investigation. A recovery plan is being  
16 formulated.

17 MR. GOTT: Okay.

18 MR. DODSON: I will fax you a copy of our  
19 original notification with that information,  
20 supplemented by that information I just read to you.

21 MR. GOTT: Okay.

22 MR. DODSON: And you should have that  
23 shortly.

24 MR. GOTT: Now before -- your decay heat  
25 removal I ask you about? You guys are --



1 MR. DODSON: I wasn't on that particular  
2 conversation.

3 MR. GOTT: You weren't?

4 MR. DODSON: No.

5 MR. GOTT: I thought it was you I was  
6 talking to.

7 MR. DODSON: No, I don't believe so.

8 MR. GOTT: I guess we -- heat now.

9 MR. DODSON: My last understanding was  
10 that we were still releasing steam to the atmosphere  
11 via the steam dumps.

12 MR. GOTT: The steam dumps?

13 MR. DODSON: Yes. That will continue  
14 until we get the reactor cooled down. I believe we  
15 actually have to depressurize the RCS to about, I'm  
16 sorry, cooldown below 300 degrees. At approximately  
17 290 degrees we can transition or so, we can transition  
18 onto RHR.

19 MR. GOTT: Okay.

20 MR. DODSON: And we're a little ways away  
21 from that yet.

22 MR. GOTT: Okay.

23 MR. DODSON: All right.

24 MR. GOTT: And you faxed that up to me.

25 MR. DODSON: Yes, that will be five pages

1 including the cover sheet.

2 MR. GOTT: And the resident knows about  
3 this?

4 MR. DODSON: I have not spoken with the  
5 resident yes.

6 MR. GOTT: Well I understand --

7 MR. DODSON: I believe he's in the control  
8 room though.

9 MR. GOTT: I understand that at 1903 you  
10 entered Mode 4 and 1905 you terminated from the alert.

11 MR. DODSON: That's correct.

12 MR. GOTT: And the cause is still under  
13 investigation.

14 MR. DODSON: That's correct as well.

15 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you, sir.

16 MR. DODSON: And your name is?

17 MR. GOTT: Bill Gott.

18 MR. DODSON: Oh, Bill. Yes, we did talk  
19 earlier.

20 MR. GOTT: Okay.

21 MR. DODSON: Thank you very much.

22 MR. GOTT: Thank you.

23 MR. DODSON: So long.

24 (Phone call ended.)

25 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center this is a

1 recorded line.

2 MS. BURTON: May I have Region 1 Public  
3 Affairs please? It's Nancy Burton and I'm with the  
4 Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone.

5 MR. GOTT: Nancy?

6 MS. BURTON: B-U-R-T-O-N.

7 MR. GOTT: B-U-R-T-O-N and what's your  
8 organization again, ma'am?

9 MS. BURTON: It's called Connecticut.

10 MR. GOTT: Okay.

11 MS. BURTON: Coalition.

12 MR. GOTT: Coalition.

13 MS. BURTON: Against Millstone.

14 MR. GOTT: Millstone.

15 MS. BURTON: Yes, and I'm calling because  
16 there's a problem at Unit 3.

17 MR. GOTT: Okay. Can I get a telephone  
18 number?

19 MS. BURTON: Sure, 203.

20 MR. GOTT: 203.

21 MS. BURTON: 938.

22 MR. GOTT: 938.

23 MS. BURTON: 3 952.

24 MR. GOTT: 52. Okay. Hold on a second,  
25 ma'am.

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1 MS. BURTON: Thank you.

2 (Discussion off record.)

3 MR. GOTT: We're telling her right now and  
4 we're giving her the phone number and she'll give it  
5 -- That public affairs person, Diane Screnci.

6 MS. BURTON: Right.

7 MR. GOTT: Will give you a call right  
8 away.

9 MS. BURTON: Thank you so much.

10 MR. GOTT: Okay?

11 MS. BURTON: Right oh.

12 MR. GOTT: Yes ma'am. And if she doesn't  
13 get back to you give us call back here.

14 MS. BURTON: I surely will but I should  
15 hear from her shortly.

16 MR. GOTT: Yes, my partner is telling her  
17 your phone number right now.

18 MS. BURTON: Thank you so much.

19 MR. GOTT: Yes ma'am.

20 MS. BURTON: Right. Bye-bye.

21 (Phone call ended.)

22 MR. GOTT: I'm calling him back to tell  
23 him I didn't get the fax.

24 MR. PARTICIPANT: Millstone Unit 3 Control  
25 Room.

1 MR. GOTT: Hi. This is the NRC OPS Center  
2 calling for Mr. Dodson.

3 MR. PARTICIPANT: Mr. Dodson.

4 MR. GOTT: Yes, he just called in with a  
5 notification.

6 PARTICIPANT: I don't believe he is in the  
7 control room. He may be in the Emergency Operations  
8 Facility.

9 MR. GOTT: Okay. What's the number over  
10 there?

11 PARTICIPANT: Hang on a second and let me  
12 see if I can find the number for them.

13 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you.

14 (Discussion in background.)

15 MR. PARTICIPANT: Sir are you there?

16 MR. GOTT: Yes, I'm here.

17 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay. The number would  
18 be (860).

19 MR. GOTT: Okay.

20 MR. PARTICIPANT: 447.

21 MR. GOTT: 447.

22 MR. PARTICIPANT: 1791.

23 MR. GOTT: 1791.

24 MR. PARTICIPANT: That will get you to the  
25 switchboard and then it's 6500.

1 MR. GOTT: 6500.

2 MR. PARTICIPANT: That's correct.

3 MR. GOTT: Okay. Do you think Mr. Dodson  
4 is over there?

5 MR. PARTICIPANT: I believe he's in the  
6 EOF. Yes.

7 MR. GOTT: Okay. Well, if he comes  
8 through there.

9 MR. PARTICIPANT: I can have him call you.

10 MR. GOTT: Yes, call me or refax the event  
11 notification because it didn't come through.

12 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay.

13 MR. GOTT: Thank you.

14 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay.

15 MR. GOTT: Bye.

16 MR. PARTICIPANT: Bye.

17 (Phone call ended.)

18 MR. GOTT: One hour.

19 VOICE MAIL MESSAGE: Hello, you have  
20 reached the Dominion Millstone Power Station. Please  
21 listen to the following options. If you are calling  
22 from a touch tone telephone and know the extension of  
23 the person you are calling, you may enter that number  
24 now.

25 MR. GROGAN: Good evening. Jim Grogan

1 speaking.

2 MR. GOTT: Hi, Mr. Grogan. This is the  
3 NRC Operations Center.

4 MR. GROGAN: Yes.

5 MR. GOTT: I'm trying to get a hold of  
6 Dave Dodson. He just made an event report to the NRC.

7 MR. GROGAN: Okay. You're trying to get  
8 a hold of Mr. Dave Dodson.

9 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

10 MR. GROGAN: He is not down here in the  
11 Tech Support Center but I can try to get a hold of him  
12 to give you a call. Do you have a number because we  
13 just terminated?

14 MR. GOTT: Yes, I know and he was faxing  
15 me your event notification sheet and it did not come  
16 through.

17 MR. GROGAN: Okay. Do you want to hold  
18 and I'll see if he's still in the EOF if he's left  
19 yet?

20 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you, sir.

21 MR. GROGAN: What is your name? I'm going  
22 to have Mr. Dodson call you.

23 MR. GOTT: My name is Bill Gott.

24 MR. GROGAN: Bill Gott.

25 MR. GOTT: Yes.

1 MR. GROGAN: I have him on the other line.  
2 I gave him the phone number that came up on my phone  
3 which is (301) 816-5102.

4 MR. GOTT: 5-100 would be fine.

5 MR. GROGAN: 5-100?

6 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

7 MR. GROGAN: Okay. And I'll have him call  
8 you while he's trying to fax.

9 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you.

10 MR. GROGAN: Yes.

11 (Phone call ended.)

12 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center this is a  
13 recorded line.

14 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Yes sir. This is  
15 Millstone Unit 3.

16 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

17 STATION DUTY OFFICER: This is the Station  
18 duty officer. I need to verify that the ERDS system  
19 is deactivated.

20 MR. GOTT: Okay. You guys have turned it  
21 off.

22 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Yes sir.

23 MR. GOTT: Okay. I'm going to put you on  
24 hold and go take a look over here.

25 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Okay.

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1 (Phone call ended.)

2 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center this is a  
3 recorded line.

4 MR. MATTHEWS: Hi, this is David Matthews,  
5 the EO for NRR. Did you just page me?

6 MR. GOTT: Yes, Millstone Unit 3 reached  
7 Mode 4 at 1903 and terminated their Alert at 1905.

8 MR. MATTHEWS: Thank you very much for the  
9 notification.

10 MR. GOTT: Okay sir.

11 MR. MATTHEWS: Thanks. Bye.

12 MR. GOTT: Bye.

13 (Phone call ended.)

14 MR. GOTT: Sir, are you there?

15 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Yes sir.

16 MR. GOTT: I'm not really get indication  
17 here but I'll call up to ERDS people upstairs and tell  
18 them to secure connection.

19 STATION DUTY OFFICER: I understand you  
20 will check the status of the ERDS. We have  
21 deactivated it here and I was making sure that it's --

22 MR. GOTT: Yes, I'll call upstairs and  
23 they have a way of hanging it up from the computer  
24 room.

25 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Okay.

1 MR. GOTT: Okay?

2 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Yes. Thank you.

3 MR. GOTT: Thank you. Bye.

4 STATION DUTY OFFICER: Bye.

5 (Phone call ended.)

6 (Phone call being made.)

7 MR. GOTT: Don't we have a person up  
8 there?

9 (Telephone recording.)

10 MR. GOTT: (Leaves message.) Yes, this  
11 is the Operations Officer down in the Ops Center. I  
12 just want to let you know that the Millstone event is  
13 no longer transmitting ERDS data. So you can  
14 terminate the Millstone ERDS link. Thank you. Give  
15 us a call (301) 816-5100 if you have any questions.  
16 Bye.

17 (Hangs up.)

18 (Phone call ended.)

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1 MS. DADDONA: Hi, this is Pat Daddona from  
2 *The Day* of New London, Connecticut.

3 MR. GOTT: Yes.

4 MS. DADDONA: I'm interested in talking  
5 with someone about the plant shutdown in Waterford  
6 today.

7 MR. GOTT: Okay. Can I get your name  
8 again?

9 MS. DADDONA: Sure. It's Pat. Last name  
10 is D as in dog, A-D-D-O-N-A with *The Day* which is a  
11 newspaper here.

12 MR. GOTT: *The Day*? Okay.

13 MS. DADDONA: Yes.

14 MR. GOTT: Can I get your phone number?

15 MS. DADDONA: Eight-six-0.

16 MR. GOTT: Eight-six-zero.

17 MS. DADDONA: Seven-0-one.

18 MR. GOTT: Seven-zero-one.

19 MS. DADDONA: Four-three-two-four.

20 MR. GOTT: Four-three-two-four.

21 MS. DADDONA: I usually deal with Neil  
22 Sheehan or Diane Screnci but I don't know because it's  
23 the weekend who's on.

24 MR. GOTT: Diane Screnci was in Region  
25 Office and so what I was going to do is hang up and

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1 then call there and give them your number and have her  
2 give you a call back.

3 MS. DADDONA: Great.

4 MR. GOTT: And if she doesn't get a hold  
5 of you, it was Diane Screnci like I said, if she  
6 doesn't get a hold of you, give us a call back and  
7 we'll try it again.

8 MS. DADDONA: Okay. Thank you.

9 MR. GOTT: Is that okay with you?

10 MS. DADDONA: Well, yes.

11 MR. GOTT: Because she's been getting a  
12 couple calls. I'm not sure if you want to call their  
13 Incident Response Center and see.

14 MS. DADDONA: No, I need to talk to her,  
15 I think, for the questions that I have.

16 MR. GOTT: Yes, it will be her calling you  
17 back.

18 MS. DADDONA: Okay.

19 MR. GOTT: Okay.

20 MS. DADDONA: Thank you.

21 MR. GOTT: Yes ma'am. Bye.

22 MS. DADDONA: Bye.

23 (Phone call ended.)

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10 MR. PARTICIPANT: Department of Homeland  
11 Security. This is our secure line DCC speaking. May  
12 I help you?

13 MR. GOTT: This is the NRC Operations  
14 Officer, Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

15 MR. PARTICIPANT: Right.

16 MR. GOTT: We called you guys earlier  
17 regarding an alert that was declared at one of our  
18 facilities in Connecticut.

19 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay. Do you know who  
20 you talked to?

21 MR. GOTT: Let me see if I have that log  
22 entry here. Doyle.

23 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay, Mary Ann. Okay.  
24 Let me transfer you to the Senior Watch Officer. He  
25 can probably help you out.

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1 MR. GOTT: Okay.

2 MR. PARTICIPANT: Okay. Hold a second.

3 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Senior Watch  
4 Officer speaking. May I help you?

5 MR. GOTT: Yes, sir. My name is Bill  
6 Gott. I'm at Nuclear Regulatory Commission. I'm the  
7 Operations Officer here.

8 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Hi, John Frost.  
9 What can I do for you?

10 MR. GOTT: Hi, Mr. Frost. Earlier today,  
11 we notified the DHS that one of our facilities in  
12 Connecticut had declared an alert.

13 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Yes.

14 MR. GOTT: Millstone Unit 3.

15 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Yes.

16 MR. GOTT: They've secured from their  
17 alert. They've gone back to their normal operating.  
18 They're still shut down but they've terminated their  
19 alert at 1905 because they cooled down enough to meet  
20 the criteria for the condition they were in.

21 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Okay.

22 MR. GOTT: So we're providing this  
23 notification. Also the Agency, our Agency, the NRC,  
24 had gone to the monitoring mode so that we could  
25 observe what was going on and keep track of it. We're

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1 still in the monitoring mode as they continue to cool  
2 down their plant all the way to cold shutdown. But  
3 they've secured from their alert.

4 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Okay, and my  
5 understanding is this was a mechanical failure pretty  
6 much.

7 MR. GOTT: Yes, a relief valve on their  
8 steam system lifted, the transient that caused the  
9 reactor to shut down and there were a couple other  
10 complications that they're still investigating which  
11 is way they're having to cool all the way down to a  
12 cold shutdown to complete their investigation.

13 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Okay. They're  
14 probably going to be offline for a couple of days  
15 then.

16 MR. GOTT: But there appeared to be no  
17 radioactive releases or any problems like that.

18 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Okay.

19 MR. GOTT: Okay.

20 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Very good. I  
21 appreciate the update and thanks much.

22 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

23 SENIOR WATCH OFFICER: Have a good night.

24 MR. GOTT: You too. Bye.

25 (Phone call ended.)

1                   TELEPHONE OPERATOR MESSAGE: Hello, you  
2                   have reached the National Response Center. If this is  
3                   an emergency or life-threatening situation, hang up  
4                   and call 911 or local authority. If you are calling  
5                   to report a oil spoil or chemical release or

18                  This is the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

19                  MR. THREATT: Yes sir.

20                  MR. GOTT: I'm just calling to -- Earlier  
21                  we notified you of one of our facilities that had  
22                  declared an alert.

23                  MR. THREATT: Yes sir.

24                  MR. GOTT: For the Event Number 756011 and  
25                  we're just calling to let you know that they've



1 secured from their alert as of 1905.

2 MR. THREATT: This is 756011.

3 MR. GOTT: Yes sir.

4 MR. THREATT: All right. I'll pass that  
5 down.

6 MR. GOTT: Can I get your name?

7 MR. THREATT: The last name T-H-R-E-A-T-T.

8 MR. GOTT: Okay. Thank you.

9 MR. THREATT: Thank you.

10 MR. GOTT: Bye.

11 MR. THREATT: Bye.

12 (Phone call ended.)

13 MR. GOTT: NRC OPS Center Support Line.

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
