Dear Mr. Prince:

I am writing this letter to request access to the records related to NUMEC and Westinghouse Nuclear Fuels Division that are available at your facility for our contractor, Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU), and its team.

In 2000, the U.S. Congress passed the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act (EEOICPA or the Act) which provided for monetary compensation and medical care for Department of Energy (DOE) employees exposed to radiation during employment and subsequently diagnosed with certain cancers. The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) was given responsibility for determining occupational radiation doses for workers making claims under the Act. ORAU was contracted by NIOSH to perform the dose reconstructions. As prescribed by the Act, ORAU is obligated to search for all data/records that may be useful for this task.

The records in which we are interested are related to NUMEC for their Apollo and Parks Township facilities, and Westinghouse Nuclear Fuels Division located in Cheswick, PA. We would like to review these records at a location convenient for you and then be allowed to scan or copy records of interest. We have attempted to get a listing of records in your collection using Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS); however, if there is a better listing of the records, we would be interested in getting information about it.
