

1. Training for Individuals working in or Frequenting Restricted Areas.

The Navajo Regional Department of Transportation has a yearly 8 hour refresher training course for the Nuclear Gauge users. The training consists of safety, handling, Hazmat, and transportation of the Nuclear Gauge which is conducted by Troxler Electronics Laboratories, Inc. The last training class was conducted on June 16, 2004.

2. Radiation Safety Program - Survey Instruments

At the present our department does not have a radiation meter and rely on the leak test which are taken every 6 months. The instruments are stored in a separate storage building away from the main building. Only contact are the nuclear gauge users and are require to wear a radiation detection badge. These badges are exchanged every three months.
