The application from Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC, for a license from NRC to build and operate a commercial pool type industrial irradiator in Honolulu, Hawaii, is subject to review and concurrence for Coastal Zone Management (CZM) federal consistency by the Hawaii CZM Program, in accordance with the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, Section 307(c), and the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 15, Part 930, Subpart D. The CZM federal consistency review and concurrence is a prerequisite to the issuance of the NRC license. The federally-approved Hawaii CZM Program identifies NRC permits and licenses for construction and operation of nuclear facilities as requiring federal consistency review.




