SUMMARY OF EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NRC BY DOMINION JANUARY 1 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005

On May 5, 2005, a NRC-licensed operator was tested for-cause at Millstone Power Station. Although the tested level was below the 10CFR26 cut-off level for alcohol and is not recorded as a positive test in this report, the individual was determined to be unfit for scheduled work activities. In accordance with 10CFR26.73(a) and (b), a 24-hour report was made to the NRC on May 5, 2005.
