In response to your request for information, we offer the following.

In recent years this office has not received complaints regarding the effluents discharged from the outfalls for the Combustion Engineering Facility at Hematite, Missouri.

There were several comments received during a public notice period in 1978 when the company sought to upgrade the sanitary wastewater treatment facilities and expand operations thereby increasing the quantity of discharge from Outfall #001. These comments resulted in a public hearing. To this office's knowledge no reprimands, legal actions, or citations for violations were required as a result of these proceedings.

Enclosed is a copy of the current NPDES discharge permit, copies of the most recent Discharge Monitoring Reports, and a copy of the most recent inspection report.
