In response to your request for information, we offer the following.

In recent years this office has not received complaints regarding the effluents discharged from the outfalls for the <u>Combustion</u> <u>Engineering Facility</u> at <u>Hematite</u>, Missouri.

There were several comments received during a public notice period in 1978 when the company sought to upgrade the sanitary wastewater treatment facilities and expand operations thereby increasing the quantity of discharge from Outfall #001. These comments resulted in a public hearing. To this office's knowledge no reprimands, legal actions, or citations for violations were required as a result of these proceedings.

Enclosed is a copy of the current NPDES discharge permit, copies of the most recent Discharge Monitoring Reports, and a copy of the most recent inspection report.
