This is in reference to your application dated August 18, 2005 requesting to renew Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-16310-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- 1. As stated in the notice of expiration which was sent to you, we reserve the right to request a complete, up-to-date application in cases where licenses have been amended frequently or are supported by a large number of fragmented or disjointed documents. We have reviewed your submission and existing license and request that you submit a single, complete application using Appendix A and B of NUREG 1556, Vol. 4, which can be found in the electronic reading room at the NRC website listed below.
- Your application should have been signed by a management representative rather than yourself. Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.
