Summary:	<p>I was informed that Mr. Smarte was not currently in the office. I requested that he return my phone call.</p> <p>09:45 Mr. Smarte returned my call. I asked him if the licensee had a back-up meter to the Ludlum-14C which is used to make radiation dose rate measurements. He stated that the Ludlum 177 Rate meter is calibrated for mR/hr and cpm. The unit is portable and can be used as a back-up to the Ludlum 14C when the 14C is out for calibration. I also asked Mr. Smarte about the authorization for 10 CFR 31.11 and why it was dropped from the renewal application. Mr. Smarte stated that the authorization was used at a previous location of use which has since been released for unrestricted use. There has been no use of RIA kits at the current location and the authorization should be removed. Mr. Smarte agreed to fax in a letter requesting the removal of the authorization.</p>
