By letter dated July 19, 2005, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an immediately effective Order (EA-05-007) imposing additional security measures on the transportation of radioactive material quantities of concern (RAMQC), which requires compliance with specific security measures by January 17, 2006 or before the next shipment of RAMQC thereafter.

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.202(d), the FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company consents to the Order, and is not requesting a hearing on the Perry Nuclear Power Plant docket.
