Dear Mr. Snowder:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at Qal-Tek Associates, LLC. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether Qal-Tek willfully failed to limit dosage to members of the public, failed to calibrate detection equipment, falsified irradiator training certificates, or failed to provide annual dosimetry reports to individuals.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegations were not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to this matter and considers this investigation closed.
