The Spent Fuel Project Office (SFPO) develops and implements the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's licensing and inspection program for the storage of nuclear reactor spent fuel and the domestic and international transportation of radioactive materials.

We surveyed our sections within the SFPO and have found that no final rule has resulted in and is not likely to result in the next three months on:

- 1. an annual effect on the economy of \$100 million or more;
- 2. a major increase in costs or prices for consumers, individual industries, or geographical regions; or
- significant adverse effects on competition, employment, investment, productivity, innovation, or on the ability of the United States-based enterprises, in domestic and export markets.
