To Whom It May Concern:

*Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.*, {USNRC Materials License No: 13-26260-01} at this time is entering into an agreement and/or joint venture with *St. Francis Hospital and Health Centers*. Both parties believe a joint venture is warranted to better serve the health care needs of the community. Both parties believe the joint venture offers a mutually beneficial arrangement and is mutually supported as noted by signatures affixed to this document by Executive Management representatives and respective Radiation Safety Officers (RSO's).

Please note the following, *Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.*, will not Transfer Control of Materials. The joint venture between *Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.* and *St. Francis Hospital and Health Centers* calls for a 70/30 ownership with *Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.*, holding the major portion of the agreement and oversight of licensed activities. *Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.* will:

- Continue to abide by all commitments and representations previously made to the USNRC in the previous corporate form;
- Agree to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations and commitments made in the license application; and
- Accepts full liability and responsibility for the medical use of by-product material

At this time, *Indiana Heart Physicians, Inc.*, is notifying and seeking consent from the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) to proceed with this transaction by August 23, 2004. An expeditious review of this correspondence is requested.
