Dear Dr. Angileri:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 17 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-24363-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**. Your license has been issued for a ten-year term and will not expire until August 31, 2015.

1. Your renewal correspondence was silent with respect to continuing authorizations for Patrick J. McNamara, D.O., Matthew L. Viscontin, M.D. and Anthony R. Pucci, D.O. as Authorized Users. I assumed this to be an oversight and I continued authorizations for all three individuals on the renewed license.

If it is your intention to delete these individuals from your license please respond with an explicit statement for each directing us to delete them from the license.

2. Please note that we did not name Daniel C. Schultz, D.O., as the Radiation Safety Officer for this license at this time because the information in your renewal correspondence dated February 17, 2005, was insufficient to complete our review. If you wish to pursue this request, please submit the following information and address it to my attention as "additional information control number 314210." I continued the authorization for Michael A. Angileri, M.D. as RSO as a temporary measure.

10 CFR 35.24(b) requires, in part, that a licensee's management shall appoint a Radiation Safety Officer who agrees, in writing, to be responsible for implementing the radiation protection program.

Please submit a letter, currently dated and signed by Daniel C. Schultz, D.O., stating that he accepts the position as RSO for this license and that he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with this position.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available

Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
