The Green Room of our Hematite Plant is presently licensed to process up to 5% enriched uranium in "limited safe" batch quantities (reference, our application of October 21, 1957). We are respectfully requesting that the license be amended to permit processing up to 6% enriched uranium in "limited safe" batch quantities as listed in Table XIV of the Fifth Revision of K-1019. Equipment and processing procedures now approved for 5% enriched uranium will remain unchanged.
