The purpose of the conference call was to address concerns that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is not the appropriate agency that should be performing the review and subsequently license the Model No. ES-3100. It was suggested the Department of Energy (DOE), EM-5, is the appropriate agency.

BWXT Lynchburg and Nuclear Fuel Services representatives stated that they are NRC Licensees and they will be transporting NRC Licensed material in the Model No. ES-3100.
