The Commission has disapproved the staff's recommendation to discontinue the annual status report on Generic Safety Issues (GSIs). The staff should reformat the annual status report to provide comprehensive summaries on all 16 open GSIs. Each summary should include the date the issue was opened, a brief description of the issue, the current status, potential problems, reasons for schedule changes, resources expended, technical contacts, and a table of milestones and completion dates for each of the 7 stages described in Management Directive 6.4, "Generic Issues Program."

The staff should develop a plan to focus renewed attention to the GSI program that will resolve the older generic issues still on the books and ensure that future generic issues are resolved in a timely manner.
