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Subject: Environmental Samples from Honeywell

I received preliminary numbers for the air monitoring stations near the site. Final numbers will be issued by the state of Illinois once the appropriate decay time has passed. The preliminary results were:

Closest monitoring station (75 yds downwind from site boundary) was about 8.0×10^{-13} microcuries/milliliter. Typical value seen here is usually about 8.5×10^{-15} , so the release was about 2 orders of magnitude above the normal mean.

Monitoring station about 1 mile downwind was about 3.3×10^{-13} microcuries/milliliter.

Monitoring stations upwind showed values within normal variances, but at the upper end of the normal ranges.
