I just got off the phone with Illinois (RICHARD ALLEN 217-782-1322); Richard advised me that they did respond to the Honeywell event on Monday, took environmental samples (air, soil & vegetation), and are currently counting these samples. Air sample results are expected to be available later today, the others in a few days.

Richard will be on leave for the holidays; however, two people that work for him and are performing the analyzes are as follows:

I advised Richard that our AIT, will be returning to the area next Monday, and that Jay Henson, or perhaps someone else in the NRC will be calling Gary or Larry for environmental data results.

Presumably, the State linked up with someone from Honeywell, but I have no evidence of that, and I don't think you do either.

I also advised Richard that as of this morning, DURATEK has been contracted by Honeywell to perform environmental sampling

I spoke again to Doe, Paul Neeson, and Paul continues to be puzzled that the State did not seek assistance from DOE. The State advised DOE that since the country is on Orange Alert, they didn't have to bother DOE with this event, which is the reason that Paul continues to be puzzled.
