Time Line of Events

Date	Description
7/2/02	Assigned to TARP team. Read procedure SH.OP-AP.ZZ-0101(Q), POST-TRANSIENT RESPONSE REQUIREMENTS and told my supervisor I have no qualifications on Emergency Event Classification Guide and do not meet the procedural requirements for this important to safety procedure.
7/2/02	Performed Corrective action program review and found hundreds of events at PSEG Nuclear for failure to follow procedures that are important to safety.
7/12/02	Supervisor [REDACTED] starts to verbally threaten me on my safety issue at end of a PSA meeting. Verbal threats and intimidation are ongoing until I am relieved of duty on [REDACTED].
7/16/02	Met with my manager, [REDACTED] on my safety issue. Based on concerns a new "volunteer" was found, Jim Melchionna. Jim Melchionna's assignment is documented in Significance Level 2 CAQ Order 70025561 act. 0030.
[REDACTED]	Based on meeting with [REDACTED] I generate Significant Level 3 Notification [REDACTED] - TARP Procedure non-compliance.
8/5/02	Manager, [REDACTED] completes response to Notification [REDACTED].
[REDACTED]	Supervisor [REDACTED] gives me a copy of [REDACTED] complete response to significant Level 3 Notification [REDACTED] - TARP Procedure non-compliance. I was told, based on [REDACTED] response that I have no safety issue and need needed to make a decision now.
[REDACTED]	After requesting time to read [REDACTED] response to Significant Level 3 Notification [REDACTED] - TARP Procedure non-compliance, I was relieved of duty due to "insubordination".
[REDACTED]	At 1315 I was relived of duty and escorted out of the protected area and told to leave the owner controlled area. My co-worker [REDACTED] was in the area and can testify to the actual course of events.
8/19/02	Required to attended offsite meeting with two supervisors, [REDACTED] & Bob Settle, before I could return to work.
8/19/02	As a condition of employment I needed to accept the following conditions: TARP Engineering position, no "railing" about safety performance indicators and not to say bad things about station management. I capitulated to all condition.
8/29/02	At this meeting I again reiterated my safety concerns and stated their actions had created a hostile work environment for raising safety concerns and have created a chilling effect.
8/29/02	Although I agreed to all conditions of employment I was still suspended and told to leave the owner controlled area. This was retracted later that day.
8/20/02	All administrative hold and access restored.
8/20/02	Contacted NRC Resident Inspector, Joseph Schoppy, for guidance and to express my safety concerns on retaliation related to protected activates.
8/27/02	Contacted Thomas Lake from PSEG Empl Concerns to discuss my safety concerns.
11/18/02	Thomas Lake from PSEG Empl Concerns completes Nuclear Safety concern Number: 737. Report concludes that supervisor action against me were appropriate.
