SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF POSSESSION LIMIT IN ENVIROCARE LICENSE

Dear Mr. Finerfrock:

We understand that in Amendment 21 of the Envirocare of Utah (Envirocare) license for low-level radioactive waste disposal issued by the State of Utah, you merged the Envirocare low-level radioactive waste disposal license with the Envirocare license for portable gauges. In combining the two licenses, the possession limit table was modified to add the gauges and sources Envirocare is licensed to possess. One of the sources is listed in Item 6.K of the table as a "Custom source - 55 gallon drum containing Depleted Uranium shavings in a homogeneous concrete mix." Under "Authorized Use," Item 9.J, it states that that item is for operational checks and efficiency determinations of radiation detection instrumentation.

As you are aware, we are in hearing on the Louisiana Energy Services (LES) project for a gas centrifuge uranium enrichment facility proposed to be located in Lea County, New Mexico. One of the intervenors in the hearing has suggested that the depleted uranium source in Item 6.K of the Envirocare license is a waste disposal limit for depleted uranium and is not a possession limit for an instrument calibration source. We would, therefore, appreciate it if you would clarify by September 16, 2005, in writing the possession limit for the depleted uranium custom source listed in Item 6.K and the authorized use of it under "Authorized Use," Item 9.J, of the Envirocare license. Please also clarify whether there is a quantity limit for disposal of depleted uranium.
