Dear Dr. Muller-Runkel:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 66 renewing your NRC Material License No. 13-02047-02 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please note the following concerning your renewed license:

1. Dr. Mulmalla was not added to your renewed license. When the preceptor form is complete, you may provide that information as an amend your NRC license.
2. Dr. Prock was not authorized for intravascular brachytherapy at this time. Please provide the information contained on the NRC website under emerging technologies as an amendment to your NRC license.
3. Therapeutic Nuclides Model 67600 was not authorized for medical use since these sources could not be found on the Sealed Source and Device Registry (SSDR). Therefore, they are listed on your license for storage only incident to disposal. If you find information on the SSDR which authorized these sources for medical use, please provide this information as an amendment to your NRC license.
4. Please note that Subitem 6.B. excludes generators since you excluded generators from all your authorized users.
5. Please note that 10 CFR 35.500 was removed from your license and authorized users since it was excluded from your application.
6. Your americium-241 sources were removed from your license since they are authorized by 10 CFR 35.65 as reference sources.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
