Subject: PSEG Nuclear security in the news

Dave Garchow, VP Operations, gave us a heads up this afternoon that KYW - 3 planned to air a piece on PSEG Nuclear security on the 7 PM news. We stopped by to get more details from the security manager, Garland Gibson. Garland mentioned that the segment was associated with interviews conducted on site several weeks ago by a CBS female reporter out of New York. Apparently, CBS New York plans to air the segment tonight too. According to Garland, the report will show a few PSEG Nuclear security folks on camera (in the shadows with muffled voices) expressing the following concerns: (1) they need more people, (2) they need better training, (3) they need better equipment (radios), and (4) deficiencies were identified in the 1998 OSRE.

Garland vehemently claims these issues to be outright lies. Walt Hunter (a KYW 3 reporter) offered Garland an opportunity to respond to this report. Garland is awaiting word from above (Harry Keiser) as to whether or not PSEG Nuclear will respond on the air tonight.

There have been no recent security allegations that the residents are aware of.
