Mark,  
I stopped by to speak with you but you weren't in your office. I have a simple question. How many and which PSEG folks did you talk to?

The reason for the question is as follows. At yesterday's OI prioritization meeting, a question was asked as to whether we should consider sending a letter to PSEG informing them about the results of OI's review. We normally do that in the case of a full OI investigation that is not substantiated, where several members of the licensee's staff have been interviewed. However, in this instance, your review was considered an Assist and not a full investigation. I was asked to call Ed Baker to get a read. Ed's response was that it should be looked at on a case-by-case basis, considering the issue involved, the number of people interviewed, and the level of people interviewed. I told Ed that I thought you had interviewed [redacted] personally, but I wasn't sure. Ed responded that if you had interviewed [redacted] then we should send a letter to PSEG summarizing your effort. Thanks.
