3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel sailed from Adelaide, Australia on October 24, 2003. The ocean transportation from Adelaide, Australia to Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada will be the responsibility of Columbus Steamship Line. The vessel will unload at Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada on November 20, 2003. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Ranier, MN. The containers will enter the USA at Ranier, MN on/about November 29, 2003, and will continue on rail to Chicago, IL.
