
We have completed the hydrologic and hydraulic analysis for the reach of Joachim Creek in Jefferson County, Missouri, from State Highway 21A to above the community of Hematite. The 100-year frequency flood elevation in the vicinity of the Combustion Engineering facility was determined to be about 435.5 feet msl.

This study will be published in a brief report and is expected to be available shortly after 15 March 1980. I will be happy to send you a copy when it is available.
