

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Dear Mr. Kinneman:

The purpose of this letter is to comply with the financial assurance requirements of 10CFR 30.35. The Bureau of Nuclear Engineering within the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has a U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license #29-07009-05 for the possession, use or storage of radioactive materials. The license covers DEP facilities located at 25, 33 and 35 Arctic Parkway, Ewing, New Jersey.

The Department intends to utilize State monies to cover decommissioning costs. Based upon the table the required financial assurance amounts as of October 3, 2003 and the types and quantities of radioactive materials licensed, the NRC has increased the funding that is required from \$150,000 to \$225,000. By this letter, the Department is certifying its intention of providing these monies, if required for any decommissioning activities.
