ISSUANCE OF EXPORT LICENSE FOR SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIAL

We are enclosing for your signature a license to United Nuclear Corporation, Hematite, Missouri, which authorizes the export to Japan of 164 grams of U-235 contained in uranium enriched to 1.65% and 3 grams of U-235 contained in uranium enriched to 3.2%.

The applicant has stated that the material, in the form of uranium dioxide pellets and powder, will be used by the ultimate consignee for experimental purposes.

The Division of International Affairs has determined that the proposed export is subject to all the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Cooperation Between the Government of the United States and the Government of Japan for Civil Uses of Atomic Energy, which entered into force on July 10, 1968, and has advised us that in its view, the issuance of the license is not inimical to the interests of the United States. OSMM, DML, and OGC also have concurred.

In accordance with your understanding with the Commission and the JCAE staff, they will not be informed of the export of this small quantity of special nuclear material.
