Dear Mr. Bauser:

This is to inform the Joint Committee of the issuance by the Commission of a license to Gulf United Nuclear Fuels Corporation, Hematite, Missouri, for the export to Japan of 23.7 kilograms of uranium 235.

The uranium 235 is contained in 25.4 kilograms of metallic uranium, an enrichment of 93.3%. The ultimate consignee, Nuclear Fuel Industries, Ltd., Osaka, Japan, has stated that the special nuclear material will be made into plate-type fuels for the Kyoto University Reactor, Osaka, Japan and the Japan Material Testing Reactor, Ibaragi-Ken, Japan.

The proposed export of special nuclear material is within the scope of the Agreement For Cooperation Between The Government Of The United States of America And The Government of Japan Concerning Civil Uses Of Atomic Energy, which entered into force July 10, 1968, and is subject to its terms and conditions.
