Dear Mr. Bauser:

This is to inform the Joint Committee that the Atomic Energy Commission intends to issue a license to Gulf United Nuclear Fuels Corporation for the export of 7.4 kilograms of special nuclear material to Japan.

The uranium to be exported is in metallic form enriched to 93.3% in uranium 235. The applicant has stated that this special nuclear material will be made into plate type fuel for use in the Kyoto University Reactor.

The proposed export of special nuclear material is within the scope of the Agreement for Cooperation Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Japan Concerning Civil Uses of Atomic Energy, which entered into force July 10, 1968, and is subject to its terms and conditions.
